Aboriginal people all but disappeared from official colonial narratives during the nineteenth century, however they survived those difficult first decades and continued to live on the coast, on their own terms.

Historian, Dr Paul Irish explores Aboriginal people of the Sydney coastal region, from Sydney Harbour to Port Hacking, and the inland waterways of the Georges River.

Old Liverpool
Courthouse

The Old Liverpool Courthouse was originally built in 1819 as a convict barracks the second oldest in New South Wales after Hyde Park Barracks and was used as a courthouse until 1972.

Recent archaeological investigations have revealed much about the building's development and visitors can now explore the site under the guidance of an archaeologist before listening to our own version of some of the old Liverpool trials.
